

## German will to back up efforts to promote quality of Tunisian educational system



Mr. Gerard Wahlts, Deputy Secretary General in charge of International Co-operation at the German Konrad Adenauer Stiftung Foundation stressed the will of the foundation to back up the vanguard orientations of Tunisia to promote the quality of its educational system.

Mr. Wahlts pointed out, as he met, on Monday, Oct. 4, 2010, in Tunis, with Education Minister Hatem Ben Salem, that Tunisia is an open country and that its educational programmes reflect this openness and contribute to entrenching the culture of dialogue and tolerance.

He said the German foundation wishes to contribute to strengthening the reforms adopted to allow the Tunisian educational system to keep pace with the scientific and technological progress and pedagogical development.

For his part, the education minister stressed the keenness to guarantee an educational system that is able to achieve an optimal investment in human resources and their upgrading for a better integration in the national and international economic circuit.
