Tunisia takes part in International Conference on "Education Promotion Project" in Manama



Tunisia is taking part in works of the International Conference on "Education Promotion Project for 2010," held in Manama, Bahrain, on October 8-10, 2010.

Education Minister Hatem Ben Salem is leading the Tunisian delegation to these works.
