Tunisia-Sicily: Boosting co-operation in education, technical education and vocational training sectors



Boosting co-operation in the education, technical education and vocational training fields between Tunisia and the region of Sicily, Italy, was the focus of a meeting held, on Monday, Oct. 25, 2010, in Tunis, between Messrs. Hatem Ben Salem, Education Minister, and Mario Centorrino, Sicilian Minister in charge of Education and Vocational Training.

The two ministers discussed the opportunities on offer to strengthen the co-operation ties binding the two Tunisian and Italian education establishments, commending the long-standing relations between Tunisia and the region of Sicily.

The two ministers suggested to hold a conference on technical education and its prospects, to be organised on a regular basis in Tunisia and Sicily.
