Tunisia won prize at International Forum on Innovative Education in South Africa



Tunisia attended the International Forum on Innovative Education held by Microsoft International in Cape Town , South Africa last October 26-30 and won the first prize in the heading "Choice of educators " for a project presented together with other Arab countries and entitled "acceptance of the other".

This project has been worked out in the form of an educational course whose basic idea was the way to accept the other and his differences in matters of thought, sex, color and language.

Two Tunisian teachers and others of Saudi Arabia, Egypt, Jordan and Lebanon contributed to the preparation of this work in which they adopted a participative approach between pupils and teachers through the use of communication technologies.

The international jury included 50 judges and awarded the first prize to this project in view of the unanimous choice of the 600 participants of 70 countries.
