

Tunisia calls for revising education curricula in ISESCO member countries



Education Minister Taieb Baccouche called for revising education curricula in Islamic Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organisation (ISESCO) member countries, taking into consideration youth's aspirations as part of citizenship, freedom and sense of responsibility.

Mr. Baccouche was speaking during the plenary session, of the 32nd session of ALECSO's Executive Council held recently in Rabat.

He also recommended multiplying training programmes for teachers and strengthening the role of schools to become spaces of initiation to democratic practice.

Mr. Baccouche, who headed a Tunisian delegation to ISESCO Executive Council's works, also called for joining efforts to establish a prospective vision to develop the education, science,

culture and communication sectors, which are the main axes of ISESCO's action plan for the 2013-2015 period.

During his visit in Rabat, the Minister also took part in a round table on youth's role in entrenching the values of citizenship and protecting Human rights in the Islamic world.
